WOICES FOR GOOD: WOMEN ADVOCATES THROUGH THE YEARS Billie Jean King wins the U.S. Open tennis tournament and then speaks out against sexism in sports, vowing not to play in the tournament in 1973 if the women's prize money does not match the men's. Her popularity wields huge influence, and tournament officials agree to equalize the rewards. But her advocacy is most widely felt in federal legislation that ends sex discrimination in high school and college athletics.
