

Girl Scouts Western Oklahoma shares a study that fails the state of Oklahoma in women's health and extols Girl Scouts to lead the change. The GSWOK recommended resource ranks Oklahoma last in the nation in the study's health category, due to laws stripping public funding for reproductive health providers such as Planned Parenthood, laws requiring ultrasounds and mandatory waiting periods for women seeking abortions, and laws placing limits on abortions after 20 weeks.
