Does GSUSA intend to continue its relationship with and funding of WAGGGS?

Yes. GSUSA has no intention of disassociating with WAGGGS just as the USA would not disassociate from the United Nations or the Archdiocese would not disassociate from the Vatican.

What are the purposes and amounts of the financial transfers that GSUSA sends to WAGGGS annually (i.e. membership quotas, World Thinking Day Fund, etc.)? Please specify for the most recent year for which GSUSA documentation is available.

GSUSA pays a quota to WAGGGS each year based on Gross National Product (GNP) and total membership. The fee is voted upon for a triennium. GSUSA's fee for 2012-2014 is \$1.5 million. These funds come from investments. They do not come out of membership dues or Cookie royalties.
